
























How Transport Has Changed

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Used to have a steam engine now powered by an electric engine - Can travel faster
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Now have a jet engine so they can travel faster - Can carry more people - Can travel further
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can now have an electric engine not one that burns fuel - Are safer - Have more features
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can now have an electric engine not one that burns fuel - Have more features - Pay in a different way
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Made from different materials - Designed in a different way to be faster - Designed in different way for different surfaces
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can travel faster - Can carry more water - Can carry more equipment - Designed to be safer
