
Elements of our Music Curriculum

Knowledge and Understanding

(Factual)

Musicians develop a knowledge and understanding of:

- 1) the practical and technical nature of music: <u>methods, techniques, media, materials, technical</u> language
- 2) the theoretical and constructive nature of a music : <u>art movements, genres, themes, artists their art</u> and its context and significance
- 3) the expressive nature of music: the genres of music., the performance of music, the composition of music and also enabling pupils to be able to think about music and then discuss and debate it
