### Lesson objectives

To introduce the second set of phonics sounds/phonemes in French. The sounds introduced in this lesson are:

i in ique ille

### Lesson structure (with approximate timings)

- Starter: Explain aim of the lesson to the pupils: to look at the second set of 4 out of a total of 18 essential French sound patterns/phonemes so that pupils will improve their French pronunciation and also be able to speak with improved accuracy in French.  

5 mins
- Main body: Start introduction of the second set of 4 French sounds/phonemes. See Teacher Support Notes for PowerPoint breakdown and guidelines on how to best use the slides.  

25 mins
- Plenary: Can the pupils remember the 4 phonemes/phonetic sounds we learnt in the lesson? Can they also remember and repeat the French word associated with this sound? Can the pupils recall the sounds/phonemes from the previous 'Phonics & Pronunciation' lesson?  

5 mins
- Consolidation: Use the print-out sheets for desk-based activities found in the Worksheets tab.  

10 mins

### Suggested follow-up activities

- Use a dictionary to find other words containing the 4 French phonemes from the lesson.
- Play the karaoke song video/mouth mechanics guide video to practise the phonetic sounds and pronunciation.
